Hello all,

I have had requests from people for **Katherine carnival** entry forms.

I have emailed these out before, but have attached them again for those who didn't receive or lost the email.

The attachment has 5 pages. Two are information about the carnival, 1 page is the swimmer "code of conduct", one is the "consent / medical form", and the other is the "entry form".

We need three forms returned with the correct entry fees (\$3.50/event) and the travel money (\$350.00/swimmer or \$250.00/parent helper).

Money and forms need to be given to either Sue or myself by the weekend. If you need a little longer to pay for the bus, that's OK, but entry forms definitely by Saturday. Bus money will have to be paid prior to travel.

Friday night is **our first swim meet** for the season. Jenna will have the entry book on pool deck every day this week (not Wednesday). Please have all entries in by 6.00pm Thursday evening.

Warm up will commence at 7.00pm for a 7.30pm start. Parent volunteers needed to help timekeep.

Saturday the **Masters Games** begins. The swimming competition actually starts at midday on Saturday.

The Masters Games is our major fundraising event every two years. We need as many volunteer helpers as possible every afternoon during the week to help time keep and also to help with Nellie, our hot potato van, at the opening and closing ceremonies. Because of the Games being held every afternoon there will be no afternoon training (don't forget morning training!), but the older swimmers would be most welcome to come down and help time keep after school. We are doing this for their benefit after all.
